Southern Scholarships. A Texas student, Beverly Slanton received one of the Scholarships. Motion was made for acceptance of Credentials Report, acceptance of Conference Rules as printed, and acceptance of the Official Program as corrected. President Stephen Spadaro recognized first time Delegates to ADAA, State and Local Presidents, ADAA Past Presidents, and Life Members. Delegates were assigned to reference committees. Slate of ADAA officers were presented to the House with one nominee presented from the floor for secretary, Susan Rexroat from Florida.

On Fri., Oct. 2nd, I attended the Budget meeting presented by Larry Sepin, Executive Director of ADAA. This Annual Session the main topic was the proposed new type of membership. E-member type will be voted on later today at the 2nd HOD. Getting ahead of my report I will tell you this was passed.

It was an inspiring presentation. The financial status of the Association continues to grow. The ADAA Foundation continues to grow. We have sponsorship from over 40 Corporations in 2009. Continuing Education sales are up. We continue to fulfill our contractual obligation to the Army & Air Force and hope to have the Navy on board later this year. It is even more financially beneficial for ADAA to have our annual session with ADA.

The new E-member will increase our numbers. E-members will have no dues and limited membership & benefits. The Association hopes to mentor and "grow" these assistants into active full membership. As this group grows the Association has plans to add 4 part time employees. This will be done slowly as the numbers and finance justify. By reaching out to the entire group of professional dental assistants via E-Membership we hope to attract new members.

ADAA VISION PRESENTATION, OCT. 2, 2009

The major business of the 85th Annual Conference was the change in the membership categories. In order to grow the association, to prevent a slow death, some of the Foundation Corporations and the Board of Trustees (BOT) brought forward the eMembership initiative. The BOT and the By-laws subcommittee spent the year leading up to the conference introducing the “E-Membership” through the state associations and local societies. A Vision Presentation, moderated by Kent Fletcher of Sunstar Americas, Inc, was set so all delegates would understand this new category. Two microphones, alternating between pro and con, were set up so that all delegates would have the chance to speak, question and/or comment on E-Membership before the reference committee meeting. The delegates overwhelmingly spoke for the new E-Membership category. Everyone, the BOT and delegates liked the Vision Presentation so well, the BOT has promised it use in the future.

ADAA 2ND HOUSE OF DELEGATES OCT. 3, 2009

ADAA awarded six Fellowships at this ADAA annual session with three present.. Masterships were awarded to two. This gives ADAA 65 Fellowships and 14 Masterships awarded.

2nd House of Delegates was called to order at 10:05am. The house will be a closed session to members and invited guest only. Time keeper was appointed from 6th District. Recognition of forty-three (43) Life Members and twelve (12) ADAA Past President was made.

Larry Sepin, ADAA Executive Director, present a financial report showing a eleven (11) year profit for ADAA. ADAA Annual Session has also showed a profit since 1993. Our investments have grown to a healthy balance with the need of further investments. Non-dues income has continued to grow as well as Sponsorships. There is still a need of encouraging current members to continue their membership. We are seeing a loss in renewing memberships. There are over 250,000 dental assistants in the nation and we only have 3% of that number.

Report of Election Committee report was given with the following elected: Pres.-Elect. Natalie Kawecky, CDA, RDARF, CDPMA, COMSA, MADAA, BA; Vice-Pres. Claudia Pohl, CDA, RDA, BVED, FADAA; Sec. Susan M. Rexroat, EDDA< CDPMA< CDA< MS.

By-laws committee chairman presented the proposed amendment to Article IV - Membership, as printed in the ADAA Journal. Committee moved for approval of the amendments. It was carried by a 2/3rd vote. This change struck International and Associate membership. A Proviso was added to Section 2A-5-b) i. A Section B5 was added : Privileges of E-Membership. Strike Payment under Article V – Dues.

Motions were made to rescind Resolutions II.H. Infection Control in the Dental Office (1986) and ILM Center for Disease Control Recommendations and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Concerns (1992). Both motions carried.

The Budget was presented and moved to adopt. Motion carried.

New Business: 7th District asks that the ADAA Board of Trustees be active in Health Care. Question brought forward about redistricting locals and states. This would be something the Board will be reviewing.

2nd House adjourned at 11:15 am.
